Hello, CTK Families.

I recognize that technology is very much a part of our lives. Children use tablets, laptops, and cell phones for a number of educational activities, but what information and how information is shared is often unregulated when it comes to artificial intelligence (AI) companies and how they train their systems.

I am encouraging you all to be aware of how your children engage with the internet generally and social media specifically. There are AI platforms that assist in child exploitation. Images of children on social media can be used to generate inappropriate images. For example, a photo of your child posted to Instagram can be taken, generated through an AI platform, and create an inappropriate photo of your child to be distributed for sexual exploitation. AI can provide conveniences for our lives, but sadly just like anything else, it can be abused.

#### CTK Families.

For those of you who are unaware, my name is Matthew Klein and I accepted the position of Athletic Director for Christ The King School just before the start of the 2023-2024 school year. All of you know me as the PE Teacher along with Middle School Health, though I'm also currently the Treasurer of the Parents Guild, parent of a 7th and a 3rd-grade student, and an alumnus of CTK.

I've noticed a few things in the past couple of months on the job that I feel need to be better presented to the CTK community. All families of CTK students are members of the Parents Guild. There is a PG Board that helps coordinate the events run by the PG. All families are encouraged/expected to participate with the PG in the form of volunteering time, contacts, ideas, etc. as the Diocese requires each Catholic School to fundraise to help offset tuition. The Sports' Boosters essentially works the same way, though their fundraising helps offset league fees, jerseys, equipment, and anything that the Physical Education program needs to provide a complete program for every student. In the past, there was an understanding that members of the SB were families who had students participating in a sport at CTK. While true, the fact that SB fundraising goes towards the PE Program means that each family is a part of the SB just like the PG.

The fundraising of both the SB and the PG falls under one umbrella of CTK School, but goals for each entity are set by the overall school budget in coordination with the CTK Business Office, as well as fundraising guidelines as set forth by the Diocese of Buffalo.

In taking the position of A.D. my duties cover coordination of coaches for our sports teams, ensuring payments are made for any league fees, helping assist coaches with the distribution of uniforms, securing fields/courts/ arenas/rinks for participation, and working collaboratively with the SB to make sure communication with the CTK families and surrounding community is being done. What I've come to realize is that the SB Board has taken a major hit this year with families leaving the school who were heavily involved. The SB Board's responsibilities have fallen on a few remaining members who have done an admirable job so far but need more help.

#### Call to Action:

The Sports Boosters needs an influx of new active members to help carry on the great tradition set forth by previous members. The SB events are the Mum Sale, Fall Fest Basket Raffle, Laux Sporting Goods Apparel Sale, and the Boys and Girls Basketball Tournament. These events are staples of the SB program, though we are not limited to only these events. Peter Streit has stepped up to lead the Sports Boosters for the remaining school year along with next year. You would be volunteering time to make sure we have enough volunteers, supplies, etc. for the existing events along with those current active Board members. With that said there are parents available with experience and notes on these events so no one is joining and having to start from scratch.
