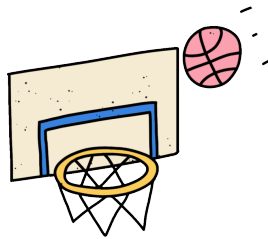
Pathway to Remembrance bricks will be available soon for purchase; please look for the display in the rectory as well as flyers in student folders coming soon!
