The girls dropped their final game of the season against their "Main St. rivals," St. Ben's on Wed., 2/12. They enter the Holy Hoopsters playoffs as the #2 seed and will play Wednesday, 2/26 at CTK against Nichols at 7pm. It has been wonderful this year to watch our 6th graders take our 4th graders Alex K., Arielle D., and Malon H. under their wing and for all of them to "gel" together as the true epitome of what a team should look like!

Recap for the JV boys game on 1/27:

The JV boys played another tough game against a much taller Nichols squad at home last week. The team tallied 28 points in the loss, with seven players scoring baskets. Jordan lead the charge with two 3-pointers, while David, Robert, Russell, Adam, John, and Javonne each drained a bucket. Teddy, Oliver, and Alessandro were solid on defense. The boys entered the playoffs as the 4th seed and played the #1 seed Nichols last night. They put up a great fight, though lost 39-32. What is this program?

What do I need to do?

1. Every CTK family is asked to participate in at least one month.

3. Sign up for an open slot for one of the items requested for that month.
4. Bring in your item (preferably labeled) to the main office on the selected day by 10:00am.
5. If bringing in something like pizza that might be time sensitive to keep warm the first teacher lunch is 10:30am.



Tips to Remember!

- ☒ Bringing in a hot item? It must be already hot and kept in something such as a crock pot to stay warm. The only way teachers have to warm things up is a microwave and small counter-top toaster oven.
- ☒ Label your item as "Teacher Appreciation Lunch" and if there are any common allergies in it - gluten, nuts, dairy.  
Disposable containers are best, but if you send in something you want back, please label it with your name and a grade level so we can make sure it gets back home.
