Students may come out of uniform on Monday, in green, with a \$1 donation. Happy St. Patrick's Day!

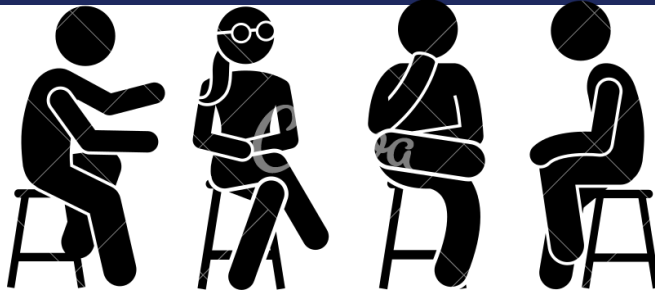
